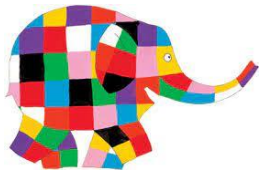
### ROOM ON THE BROOM

This week we will use the puppets to retell the story of Room on the Broom, decorating our own wands using different materials and using our fine motor skills to manipulate playdough into different shapes.



### DIWALI

This week we will be learning about the celebration of Diwali. We will be exploring traditional Indian clothing, making our own Diya lamps and listening to the story of Rama and Sita.



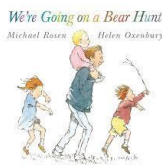
### ELMER

We will begin our week of learning by listening to the story of Elmer and creating our own large Elmer by using lots of coloured squares to collage. We will also be using the paint to participate in colour mixing.



### THE GRUFFALO

During this week the children will become familiar with the Gruffalo story and have the opportunity to explore the different animal homes. We will be going on a Gruffalo hunt in the garden whilst retelling the story looking for animal tracks and homes.



### WE'RE GOING ON A BEAR HUNT

When the children come into the nursery they will be greeted by a bear cave which we will be exploring. We will share the story together and later in the week retell the story by exploring the different elements using our feet.



### STICK MAN

During this week of learning we will be looking at the story of Stick man. The children will make their own stick man character and decorate him with clothes, create and use our own stick paintbrushes & ordering different sticks into height order.



### CHRISTMAS

Over the two weeks we will be talking about our family's traditions and how we celebrate Christmas. The children will have the chance to explore how different countries celebrate Christmas and saying Merry Christmas in our home languages. We will also be creating our own Christmas cards, calendars and performing our Christmas play to all parents.

### STAY, PLAY AND LEARN SESSIONS

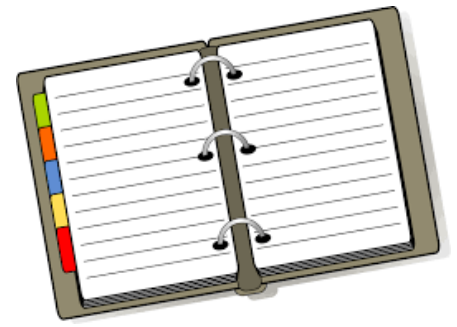
