THE THREE LITTLE PIGS

Whilst looking at the 'Three Little Pigs' we will be concentrating on building with different materials in the garden, exploring the Three Little Pigs sensory area and looking at what materials are strong and can hold against strong wind. We will be learning about how different people around the world live.

GOLDILOCKS AND THE THREE BEARS

This week we will sharing the story of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears', we will then talk about who the characters are and discuss their behaviors.

The children will explore the emotions and feelings of the bears as they role play in the focus area.

This term we will be looking at popular fairytale stories.


JACK AND THE BEANSTALK

During group times we will be reading the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. Following this we will create our own beanstalks and learn how to count from 1 – 10. We will learn how to compare different sized objects and make our own giants house with the large construction materials. In the water tray we will explore bubbles and bricks.



ITTLE RED RIDING HOOD

We will be thinking about the journey Little Red Riding Hood took and talking about the different journeys we take to nursery every day. We will be looking at the colour red and identifying different red objects in the school. We will be looking at our facial features and talking about what makes us different.



THE THREE BILLY GOATS GRUFF

This week we will be challenging our physical skills by using our bodies to climb up the stairs and then balancing as we move across the bridge. The children will be ordering objects into different sizes of small, big and biggest.
