Topic this term - 'Out of this world'

Our topic for the half term is 'Out of this World'. We will be learning about different types of places in and around the world. Attached is a curriculum map and vocabulary list for this half term.

We have read the story 'Aliens Love Underpants' this week.

We will move our learning to the jungle when we read 'Rumble in the jungle'. We will use this book to learn about rhyming words.

After the jungle we will dive under the sea to learn about sharks. The following week we will use the Octonauts as inspiration to write our own creature reports about different creatures that live in the ocean.

For the last week of term, we will go back in time to discover how the dinosaurs lived and what they ate.

Reading and writing

Introduce Phase 3 digraphs (two letters that make one sound)	Form lower-case letters correctly
Blend phonemes to read CVC words such as cat, c-a-t, dad, d-a-d, dog d-o-g, sh-o-p, r-i-ng	Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s
Read tricky words, which are words that do not follow the pattern of what has been taught so far in phonics.	Write short sentences with words with known sound-letter correspondences


