PAB Enrichment Clubs

We are pleased to be able to offer Enrichment Clubs for our Summer Term. Due to the half term these clubs will run for 10 weeks, starting the **week beginning Monday 22nd April and ending on the Friday 5th July**. Clubs will run from 3.20pm to 4.20pm and the cost is stated next to the club in the table below, along with any dates the club is unable to run.

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer children After School Club as well as an Enrichment Club on the same day. Therefore, please bear this in mind when selecting a club for your child.

If your child has regular bookings in After School Club and you would like to suspend these for the duration of the Enrichment Club please email the school office.

We will be allocating places to ensure that as many children as possible can participate and will try and take into account your preferences. Please look carefully at the Year Groups each club is available to.

Please can we remind parents that if your child is allocated a space in a club but changes their mind and doesn't attend, you will still be required to pay. Therefore, we ask you to discuss the choices with your child before submitting your application. Thank you for your understanding.

- We expect the same excellent standards of behaviour from the children during the clubs as we do at school. This means that any child who does not meet these high expectations will be spoken to, as will the parents and this may lead to the child being asked to leave the club.
- Please do not make any payments until you have been told which club your child has a place in. You will be able to pay via Scopay or using Childcare vouchers. **If you do not wish to take up a place that has been offered you must let us know via email before the club starts or you will be expected to pay the full amount. There will be no "taster" sessions.**
- Children should not bring a snack or drink to any of the clubs. They will use the water bottles that they bring to school to drink from.

- It is not possible for parents/carers to watch the clubs as it is distracting for the children. Please do not arrive to collect the children more than five minutes before the end of the club. For Year 5 & 6 children, if you have given consent for your child to walk home, they will be able to do so after clubs.
- On occasion staff may have to cancel a club at short notice.

Below is some information about the clubs available

Football

All football clubs take place on the field. Appropriate clothing is needed, this includes **moulded** football boots (no studs) to allow the children more grip. Shin pads **must** be worn.

Monday Years 2/3/4 club is with our club provider Sports Elite. Please collect your child from the Gazebo on the field via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Wednesday's Years 5/6 club is with our club provider Sports Elite. Please collect your child from the Year 2 fenced Gazebo area via gates 2/3/4.

Thursday girls' football Years 4/5/6 club with Mr Bennet focussing on confidence engaging with the ball and passing over longer distances as well as improving general footballing ability. Please collect your child from the Gazebo on the field via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Board Games 2/3/4 with Miss Shaw

The children will be learning how to play a variety of different board games and card games. Children will focus on how to challenge themselves as well as working well as a team. Children do not require a change of clothes. Please collect your child from outside 2C via the 2/3/4 gate.

Kickboxing 4/5/6 with our club provider Sports Elite



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Led by Sports Elite's esteemed 1st dan black belt instructor, this club is specifically tailored for students in Years 4-6 and promises an exciting journey into the world of kickboxing. Participants can expect expert guidance as they learn fundamental techniques, self-defence, enhance physical fitness and cultivate self-discipline in a safe and supportive environment. The club will take place in the hall and children should wear appropriate active wear clothing. Collection will be from outside the hall double doors.

Arts and Crafts 2/3/4 with Miss Goldswain

The children will explore arts and crafts using a range of different media such as chalk, paint, digital media and others. Children do not require a change of clothes as aprons will be provided. Please collect your child from outside 2G via the 2/3/4 gate.

Athletics 3/4/5/6 with Mr Bennet and Mr Gillard

In Athletics the children will be running long distances, sprinting and working on relay baton change overs on track events. They will also be throwing for distance and perfecting their skills at both long jump and triple jump. All great skills for our up and coming Sports Day and District Sports. Children should wear appropriate active wear clothing and are to be collected from the Gazebo on the field via gates 2/3/4.

Netball Years 5/6 with Mrs Gale

The children will be learning how to play games of netball, developing team work skills and learning how to play with speed and accuracy. Open to both boys and girls in Years 5 and 6, Netball club will also be involved in games against schools from across the Lumen Learning Trust. Netball will take place on the playground. The children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the playground via gates 2/3/4.

Urban Dance Years 2/3/4/5/6 with club provider Urban Dance

This dynamic club takes place in the hall. Children should bring in comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the hall double doors.

Cricket Years 4/5/6 with Staines & Laleham CC

The cricket club will involve a mixture of different batting, bowling and fielding exercises with lots of fun team games and skill development in all areas of cricket. The children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the Gazebo on the field via gates 2/3/4.

Drama Years 2/3/4/5/6 with club provider Miss Gardner

An energetic workshop learning about drama through theatre games, activities and exercises. A way to improve acting and movement skills whilst having the most fun! This club will take place in the school hall. Children should bring comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the hall double doors.

Ukulele Years 2/3/4/5/6 with Mr Williams

This club offers a great opportunity to learn a stringed instrument. The club will start by learning basic chords before tackling easy songs and then progressing in line with the children's needs. Ukuleles will be provided to

use during the club. Children do not require a change of clothes. Please collect your child from outside 5W via the 2/3/4 gate.

Rounders Years 3/4/5/6 with club provider Sports Elite

Taking place on the field, the children will hone the hand-eye co-ordination skills needed in rounders. The children will take part in throwing, catching and batting exercises before taking part in fun games. Children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the Year 2 fenced Gazebo area via gates 2/3/4.

Dance Club Years 2/3 with club provider Miss Daniels

Taking place in the hall, children will be listening to various types of music and learning different dance routines. Children should bring in comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the hall double doors.
