Attendance

Whole School

At the Lumen Learning Trust, attendance and punctuality are very high priorities. Parents and Carers have a legal responsibility to ensure children come to school regularly and on time. Our schools have a legal duty to record the attendance of every child on roll and give reasons as to why they are late or absent. The following extract details information in relation to Penalty Notices:

If the Headteacher does not authorise exceptional leave in term time, and it is still taken, this is always classified as unauthorised. Parents/carers of pupils who have a period of 5 or more days (consecutive or non-consecutive) unauthorised absence are liable to receive a fixed penalty notice of £60 per parent per child to be paid within 21 days or £120 per

parent per child if paid within 28 days. Please be aware that each parent is liable to receive a Penalty Notice for each child, for example if there are two parents, and two children incur unauthorised absences each parent will receive two Penalty Notices. If the penalty is not paid in full by the end of the 28-day period the Local Authority must consider a prosecution against the recipient for failing to ensure regular school attendance under section 444 Education Act 1996.


