KGB Enrichment Clubs

We are pleased to be able to offer Enrichment Clubs for our Spring term for children in Reception in addition to Year One. We will not be offering a sports club for Reception children this term, due to cold weather and lack of indoor space provisions. We will look to introduce a Sports club option for Reception children in the Summer term.

Due to the half term these clubs will run for 10 weeks, starting the **week beginning Monday 13th January and ending on Friday 28th March**. Clubs will run from 3.10pm to 4.10pm and the cost is stated next to the club in the table below, along with any dates the club is unable to run.

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer children After School Club as well as an Enrichment Club on the same day. Therefore, please bear this in mind when selecting a club for your child.

If your child has regular bookings in After School Club and you would like to suspend these for the duration of the Enrichment Club please do so via Scopay.

We will be allocating places to ensure that as many children as possible can participate and will try and take into account your preferences. Please look carefully at the Year Groups each club is available to.

Please can we remind parents that if your child is allocated a space in a club but changes their mind and doesn't attend, you will still be required to pay. Therefore, we ask you to discuss the choices with your child before submitting your application. Thank you for your understanding.

- **If your child wishes to participate, please complete the Google Form via the following link below by 9am on Monday 6th January. We will aim to let you know as soon as possible but a text will be sent by Friday 10th January at the very latest advising of club allocations.**

- We expect the same excellent standards of behaviour from the children during the clubs as we do at school. This means that any child who does not meet these high expectations will be spoken to, as will the parents and this may lead to the child being asked to leave the club.
- Please do not make any payments until you have been told which club your child has a place in. You will be able to pay via Scopay or using Childcare vouchers. **If you do not wish to take up a place that has been offered you must let us know via email before the club starts or you will be expected to pay the full amount. There will be no "taster" sessions.**

- Children should not bring a snack or drink to any of the clubs. They will use the water bottles that they bring to school to drink from.
- It is not possible to watch the clubs as it is distracting for the children. Please do not arrive to collect the children more than five minutes before the end of the club.
- On occasion staff may have to cancel a club at short notice.

Recorder with Miss Bruton

Recorder club offers a fun and exciting opportunity to learn beginner recorder skills, how to correctly hold the instrument and play to the notes B, A and C. It's a great way to begin to read music whilst developing fine motor skills! Please collect your child from the main playground gate.

Lego Club with Miss Goldswain

LEGO club offers a fun, creative, and collaborative atmosphere where students come together to build and design with LEGO bricks. The club encourages teamwork and problem-solving as children will create structures using their imagination. Providing a space for students to explore their interests in construction and design, while also developing valuable skills like communication and critical thinking.

Please collect your child from the main playground gate.

Multisports with Mr Gillard

Multisports will give the children the opportunity to learn new skills, sports and games in a fun and engaging way. The club will help develop and improve the multi skills required for specific sports in the children's later sporting education. Appropriate layered clothing is needed for this dynamic outdoors club. Please collect your child from the main playground gate.

Football with club provider Sports Elite

This club takes place on the field. Appropriate clothing is needed, as the weather deteriorates this includes **moulded** football boots (no studs) as the field will get muddy and boots allow the children more grip. Shin pads **must** be worn. Please collect your child from the main playground gate.

Club providers will dismiss from the playground gate, if your child is being collected by someone who does not normally collect or the coach is not familiar with the adult who is collecting, they will need to provide the password before the child can be released.
