PAB Enrichment Clubs

We are pleased to be able to offer Enrichment Clubs for our Spring Term. Due to the half term these clubs will run for 10 weeks, starting the **week beginning Monday 13th January and ending on Friday 28th March**. Clubs will run from 3.20pm to 4.20pm and the cost is stated next to the club in the table below, along with any dates the club is unable to run.

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer children After School Club as well as an Enrichment Club on the same day. Therefore, please bear this in mind when selecting a club for your child.

If your child has regular bookings in After School Club and you would like to suspend these for the duration of the Enrichment Club, please do so via Scopay.

We will be allocating places to ensure that as many children as possible can participate and will try and take into account your preferences. Please look carefully at the Year Groups each club is available to.

Please can we remind parents that if your child is allocated a space in a club but changes their mind and doesn't attend, you will still be required to pay. Therefore, we ask you to discuss the choices with your child before submitting your application. Thank you for your understanding.

- **If your child wishes to participate, please complete the Google Form via the following link below by 9am on Monday 6th January. We will aim to let you know as soon as possible but a text will be sent by Friday 10th January at the very latest advising of club allocations.**

- We expect the same excellent standards of behaviour from the children during the clubs as we do at school. This means that any child who does not meet these high expectations will be spoken to, as will the parents and this may lead to the child being asked to leave the club.
- Please do not make any payments until you have been told which club your child has a place in. You will be able to pay via Scopay or using Childcare vouchers. **If you do not wish to take up a place that has been offered you must let us know via email before the club starts or you will be expected to pay the full amount. There will be no "taster" sessions.**
- Children should not bring a snack or drink to any of the clubs. They will use the water bottles that they bring to school to drink from.

- It is not possible for parents/carers to watch the clubs as it is distracting for the children. Please do not arrive to collect the children more than five minutes before the end of the club. For Year 5 & 6 children, if you have given consent for your child to walk home, they will be able to do so after clubs.
- On occasion staff may have to cancel a club at short notice.
- If your child has been selected to attend the year 6 Booster sessions, please consider this before making any club bookings.
- Please be aware that children will not be permitted to walk home after the clubs for the first part of the term due to the darker evenings, this will be reviewed after the February half term and communicated once reinstated. If your child is being collected by someone who does not normally collect or if the coach is not familiar with who normally collects, they will need to provide the password before the child can be released.

Below is some information about the clubs available

Football

All football clubs take place on the field. Appropriate clothing is needed, this includes **moulded** football boots (no studs) to allow the children more grip. Shin pads **must** be worn.

Monday Years 2/3/4 club is with our club provider Sports Elite. The children should be collected from the Year 5&6 gate where coaches will bring the children to the gate to be dismissed.



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Wednesday's Years 5/6 club is with Mr Gillard. Please collect your child from the Year 2 fenced Gazebo area via the Year 2/3/4 gate

Thursday girls' football Years 5/6 club with Mr Bennet focussing on confidence engaging with the ball and passing over longer distances as well as improving general footballing ability. Please collect your child from the Gazebo on the field via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Netball Years 5/6 with Mrs Gale & Miss Parker

The children will be learning how to play games of netball, developing team work skills and learning how to play with speed and accuracy. Open to both boys and girls in Years 5 and 6, Netball club will also be involved in games against schools from across the Lumen Learning Trust. Netball will take place on the playground. The children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the playground via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Mindfulness Y2/3 with Miss Hall

This amazing club is all about feeling fantastic by learning to be comfortable with all different emotions and how calm the mind through fun and engaging activities. It will be a perfect opportunity to calm the mind using various breathing exercises and explore the feelings with kindness and curiosity. Children should be collected from 2H via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Public Speaking 5/6 Miss Cuthbert

The club teaches children how to come up with a 'Big Idea' that they would like to share with others and equip them with the public speaking skills to be able to present their idea in front of others. Children do not require a change of clothes. Please collect your child from outside the 5C classroom via the Year 2/3/4 gate. During these sessions, the children will learn to develop tag rugby skills and applying these in game situations. All children need to bring in comfortable sportswear and trainers. Open to students of all skill levels, the club provides opportunities for practice, friendly competition, and personal growth in a supportive environment. In Athletics the children will be running long distances, sprinting and working on relay baton change overs on track events. They will also be throwing for distance and perfecting their skills at both long jump and triple jump. Children should wear appropriate active wear clothing and are to be collected from the Gazebo on the field via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

Urban Dance Years 2/3/4/5/6 with club provider Urban Dance

This dynamic club takes place in the hall. Children should bring in comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the Park Avenue Hall double doors.

An energetic workshop learning about drama through theatre games, activities and exercises. A way to improve acting and movement skills whilst having the most fun! This club will take place in the school hall. Children should bring comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Multisports with club provider Sports Elite.

Multisports will give the children the opportunity to learn new skills, sports and games in a fun and engaging way. This club's help develop and improve the multi skills required for specific. Appropriate layered clothing is needed for this dynamic outdoors club. The children should be collected from the Year 5&6 gate where coaches will bring the children to the gate to be dismissed.

Choir Years 4/5/6 with Mrs Shaw 8am – 8.35am

The children will be working towards a performance to their peers. Children need to be dropped to Miss Shaw the hall at PAB via the hall double doors for 8am. There is no charge for this club.
