Year 2 Visit to Hobbledown Farm – Wednesday 30th April 2025

The children in Year 2 will be learning about living things and their habitats in the Summer term as part of their Science curriculum. To complement this, we would like to take all the children to Hobbledown Farm in Hounslow, where they will take part in a workshop to learn about how animals move and adapt in their different habitats. They will have the opportunity to see live reptiles, insects and other creatures.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 30th April. The children will travel by coach from Park Avenue base; we will return to school at approximately 3pm, depending upon traffic. Children will need to bring a packed lunch & water bottle, in a named rucksack. Please remember no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or nuts of any kind. Children should wear their Riverbridge jumpers / cardigans with their yellow top and jogging bottoms from their PE kit, together with trainers. They should also bring a named waterproof coat and, if there is sunshine, please send a named sun hat and apply sun cream in the morning.

We may require some parent helpers to accompany us on the visit. If you are able to help please can you email office.riverbridge@lumenlearningtrust.co.uk We will then contact you once we have confirmed the number of adult helpers required and next steps.

The cost of the trip will be £23.25, which is based on all students taking part and can be paid in two instalments in March £11.50 & April £11.75. As always, if the cost is a concern, please speak to the school office in confidence.

The contribution is voluntary, however if there is insufficient support, the trip may be cancelled. As a school we cannot fund this type of enrichment visit without voluntary contributions.
