## **Year 4 Sayers Croft Residential – February 2026**

Dear Parents/Carers

This year, our Year 4 residential will take place at Sayers Croft in Ewhurst. This residential invites children to take part in an unforgettable experience in the great outdoors. The children will enjoy 3 days of outdoor activities, 2 nights accommodation in purpose built chalets and we will travel from school by coach. Our school will have its own private chalets and be supported by both Sayers Croft and Riverbridge staff. There will be a programme of activities on offer, supporting children in developing a broad range of skills, as well as offering fun and memorable experiences.

### **What is Sayers Croft?**

The children will take part in a 2 night stay and, will be entertained and engaged through a wide range of purposeful, enriching activities and workshops. Meals will be made on site, ensuring all dietary requirements are catered for. This Sayers Croft experience will provide the children with opportunities to develop key life skills whilst also creating memories that last a lifetime.

### **When?**

We will be going to Sayers Croft from **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> – Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026**. The children will be picked up by coach on Wednesday morning arriving in time for a welcome meeting, orientation & lunch before taking part in the first activity; this will be followed by an evening meal & evening activities. On the Friday the children will have breakfast, morning activities and lunch before they return to school in the afternoon. Drop off and pick up times will be communicated nearer the time.

### **Additional information**

Further information including kit list, dietary and medical forms will be sent to you in due course.

### **Payment**

The total price of the residential, including a voluntary contribution of £82 and compulsory contribution of £123, is £205 and includes: accommodation, transport, all activities/workshops and meals that are cooked on site. Unfortunately, and with regret, should we not have sufficient families paying the full amount, including the voluntary element, then we will have no choice but to cancel the trip.

To secure a place for your child we ask that you tick the online consent box on Scopay by **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2025** and make a payment for the non-refundable deposit of £10.

The cost of the residential will be payable in instalments as detailed in the following payment plan. We do appreciate that Year 4 normally have a day trip to support their Romans topic work; this will be scheduled for later in the academic year with full details to be shared next year. Please do not hesitate to make smaller more regular payments for the residential to spread the cost. The payment can be made in full if you prefer and as always, if the deposit payment and or full cost is a concern, please contact the school office in confidence.
