

## Guide to Home Learning on Purple Mash






Choose 6 quadrilaterals and describe their properties. Use the key words to help you. We will print this for your books.

7) Whilst you are completing the task, please frequently click 'Save' to make sure you don't lose your work at any stage.


You can find 'Save' by clicking on the purple box with 3 white lines in the top left corner.
