PAB Enrichment Clubs

We are pleased to be able to offer Enrichment Clubs for our Autumn Term. Due to the half term these clubs will run for 10 weeks, starting the **week beginning Monday 14th September and ending on Friday 4th December**. Clubs will run from 3.20pm to 4.20pm and the cost is stated next to the club in the table below, along with any dates the club is unable to run.

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer children After School Club as well as an Enrichment Club on the same day. Therefore, please bear this in mind when selecting a club for your child.

If your child has regular bookings in After School Club and you would like to suspend these for the duration of the Enrichment Club, please email the school office.

We will be allocating places to ensure that as many children as possible can participate and will try and take into account your preferences. Please look carefully at the Year Groups each club is available to.

Please can we remind parents that if your child is allocated a space in a club but changes their mind and doesn't attend, you will still be required to pay. Therefore, we ask you to discuss the choices with your child before submitting your application. Thank you for your understanding.

If your child wishes to participate, please complete the Google Form via the following link below by 9am Monday 7th September We will aim to let you know as soon as possible but a text will be sent by Friday 11th September at the very latest advising that all club allocations have been made.

- We expect the same excellent standards of behaviour from the children during the clubs as we do at school. This means that any child who does not meet these high expectations will be spoken to, as will the parents and this may lead to the child being asked to leave the club.
- Please do not make any payments until you have been told which club your child has a place in. You will be able to pay via Scopay or using Childcare vouchers. **If you do not wish to take up a place that has been offered you must let us know via email before the club starts or you will be expected to pay the full amount. There will be no "taster" sessions.**
- Children should not bring a snack or drink to any of the clubs. They will use the water bottles that they bring to school to drink from.
- It is not possible for parents/carers to watch the clubs as it is distracting for the children. Please do not arrive to collect the children more than five minutes before the end of the club. For Year 5 & 6 children, if you have given consent for your child to walk home, they will be able to do so after clubs.
- On occasion staff may have to cancel a club at short notice.

Below is some information about the clubs available

Football

Monday Years 2/3/4 and Wednesday's Years 5/6 clubs will be provided by our new club provider JDA Coaching. Our after school football club provides a fun, inclusive and engaging environment where children can develop their football skills, build confidence and have fun every single week. Each session includes exciting games, technical activities and small-sided matches, giving every child the opportunity to learn, stay active and enjoy the game, regardless of their previous experience or ability. Please collect your child from the Year 2 Gazbeo, entering via the year 2/3/4 gate.

Wednesday's girls' football Years 4/5/6 club with Mr Bennet will be focussing on confidence engaging with the ball and passing over longer distances as well as improving general footballing ability. Please collect your child from the Gazebo on the field via the Year 2/3/4 gate.

All football clubs take place on the field. Appropriate clothing is needed, this includes **moulded** football boots (no studs) to allow the children more grip. Shin pads **must** be worn. All children should have a refillable water bottle.

Netball Years 5/6 with Mrs Gale

The children will be learning how to play games of netball, developing team work skills and learning how to play with speed and accuracy. Open to both boys and girls in Years 5 and 6, Netball club will also be involved in games against schools from across the Lumen Learning Trust. Netball will take place on the playground. The children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the playground via gates 2/3/4.



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Musical Theater with DWX Clubs

DWX's Musical Theatre Club is a fun and engaging session where students will develop their confidence through singing, acting and dance. Each week, they will learn performance skills, take part in drama games and creative activities, and work together on fun routines inspired by popular musicals. The club encourages creativity, teamwork, communication and self-confidence in a supportive and enjoyable environment. Stickers and certificates are awarded each week to celebrate children's hard work, progress and achievements.

Handball With Sports Elite

Handball is a fun, fast-paced team sport that helps children stay active while learning new skills. Players work together to pass, catch, dribble, and throw the ball to score goals. The game encourages teamwork, communication, and good sportsmanship in a safe and supportive environment. Handball is suitable for children of all skill levels, helping them build confidence, improve coordination, and develop fitness while making new friends. With exciting games and engaging activities, kids can enjoy learning the sport, staying healthy, and having fun every step of the way. The children should be collected from the Year 5&6 gate where coaches will bring the children to the gate to be dismissed.

Basketball Years 2/3/4 with club provider Spelthorne Eagles

In Basketball, each session is full of energy, fun and skill-building. The children will learn skills such as, dribbling, passing, and shooting drills, teamwork and movement skills and coordination. Children should wear appropriate active wear clothing and are to be collected from the Year 2 Gazebo via the gates 2/3/4.

Athletics Years 3/4/5/6 with Sports Elite

In Athletics, the children will be running long distances, sprinting and working on relay baton change overs on track events. They will also be throwing for distance and perfecting their skills at both long jump and triple jump. All great skills for our Sports Day and District Sports events. Children should wear appropriate active wear clothing. The children should be collected from the Year 5&6 gate where coaches will bring the children to the gate to be dismissed.

Urban Dance Years 2/3/4/5/6 with club provider Urban Dance

This dynamic club takes place in the hall. Children should bring in comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the hall double doors.

Cricket Years 4/5/6 with Staines & Laleham CC

The cricket club will involve a mixture of different batting, bowling and fielding exercises with lots of fun team games and skill development in all areas of cricket. The children are to wear appropriate clothing and are to be collected from the Gazebo on the field via gates 2/3/4.

Riverbeats Music Club Years 3/4/5/6 with Mr Kyle

Each week we focus on different genres/eras i.e, disco/80s/soul/k-pop. Afterwards, children vote for their favourite. and we pick a winning song. We will also look at writing and performing our own songs and lyrics each week. The focus ultimately is not only having fun but to expand their musical knowledge and encourage creativity through the exploration of contemporary and older musical styles. Please collect your child/ren from the music room via 2/3/4 gate.

Multisports Years 2/3/4 with club provider Sports Elite

Multisports will give the children the opportunity to learn new skills, sports and games in a fun and engaging way. This club's help develop and improve the multi skills required for specific. Appropriate layered clothing is needed for this dynamic outdoors club. The children should be collected from the Year 5&6 gate where coaches will bring the children to the gate to be dismissed.

Drama Years 2/3/4/5/6 with club provider Miss Gardner

An energetic workshop learning about drama through theatre games, activities and exercises. A way to improve acting and movement skills whilst having the most fun! This club will take place in the school hall. Children should bring comfortable clothing that they can move around easily in. Please do not send dressing up/party clothes as these are not appropriate. The children should be collected from outside the hall double doors.

Choir Years 4/5/6 with Mrs Pardoe 12:30pm – 1pm

The children will be working towards a performance for Young Voices 2027. There is no charge for this club and it will take place on a Thursday lunch time. Children will go for lunch at 12pm.
