Junior Duke Life Skills Programme (Years 3–6)

Dear Parents/carers,

The Junior Duke Life Skills Programme is an exciting enrichment opportunity that helps children develop confidence, independence and practical life skills through a range of engaging challenges.

Children will learn new practical skills during the weekly enrichment sessions with Miss Code, practise these at home and work towards achieving recognised Junior Duke certificates and, ultimately, their Junior Duke Award.

Sessions will take place on a Wednesday Lunch times, 12:30-1pm (They will go into the hall to have their lunch from 12 noon).

How the programme works:

- Open to Years 3–6, with 6 places available per year group.
- Each child will receive a Junior Duke workbook to record their progress and use between home and school.
- Places are allocated for the academic year. Children remain in the programme until they have completed their Junior Duke Award, after which their place may be offered to a child on the waiting list.
- As places are limited, a waiting list will be maintained. Children may join during the year if places become available, with the final point of entry at the start of the Spring Term.
- Weekly sessions are available throughout the year, although children do not need to attend every week if they are making good progress independently. Attendance is strongly encouraged when new skills or certificate training are being delivered.
- If a session cannot take place due to other school commitments, families will be informed in advance wherever possible.
