Our 'Recovery' Curriculum July 2020 Overview

Subject	Phonics	Subject	English
What are we going to do in Year 1?	We will be recapping all of the Phase 2 and 3 sounds before teaching the Phase 5 sounds. We will be assessing each child in September to decide how best to support them.	What are we going to do in Year 1?	We will be working on letter formation using the Riverbridge writing script. Children will be given opportunities during planned provision to explore stories, using role play and writing.
What could you do at home?	Before September, continue to practise Phase 2 and 3 sounds. Continue to enjoy stories daily and try to blend CVC words (words made of consonant, vowel, consonant – cat, dog etc.)	What could you do at home?	Encourage verbal story-telling with your child and re-telling of traditional tales, e.g. Jack and the beanstalk. Give your child a range opportunities to write independently. This doesn't need to be sat at a table and should be however your child feels comfortable. Encourage your child to say their sentence out loud before writing it down.
Subject	Maths	Subject	Life Skills
What are we going to do in Year 1?	At school, children will be given lots of opportunities to explore numbers independently. We will begin by focussing on place value and their understanding of number.	What are we going to do in Year 1?	Through the use of continuous provision, we will be allowing children to develop their independence and communication skills. They will be given regular opportunities to collaborate with their peers and solve problems.
What could you do at home?	Practise writing numbers at home to support with number formation. Count a range of objects and encourage children to spot and recognise numbers in real life situations (e.g. clocks, door numbers etc.)	What could you do at home?	With your child, practise tying shoe laces and getting dressed independently. Try to work on fine motor skills to build finger strength, (e.g. threading, playdough, buttons, keyboard typing).
