

**If a member of your household is unwell please follow the advice below:**

Do they have a temperature/fever?

Yes

Do they have a new, continuous or persistent cough?

This means: a cough that has lasted more than hour, if they have had three or more coughing episodes in 24hours or if they are coughing more than usual.

Yes

Do they have a loss of, or change to, their sense of taste or smell?

Yes

All members of the household should stay at home.

Call school on 01784-227960 to report the child absence or complete the online absence form on our website.

Your household must isolate until test results are available.

No to all

If the symptoms are cold-like such as a runny nose, a test is not required and other members of the household do not need to isolate. If your child is not well enough to come to school please report their absence as normal.

Negative

A member of our household has taken a COVID test.

Positive

The result was...

Inform school of the result and child can return to school once well and members of the household can stop isolating.

Inform school of the positive result. Whoever took the test must isolate for 10 days from when the symptoms started. The rest of the household must isolate for 14 days and follow the testing procedures if they display any symptoms.
