



Year 1 Curriculum Map: Autumn 2

ENGLISH

This half term, we will be reading 'Traction Man is here' by Mini Grey and 'Toys in Space' by Mini Grey.

Sentence writing Punctuate a sentence using a capital letter and a full stop. Join clauses within a sentence using 'and'.

Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation Understand how words can combine to make sentences. Separate words with spaces. Use capital letters for names of people and places and for personal pronouns. Begin to use conjunctions to extend sentences.

Reading Apply phonic knowledge and skills to decode words. Read phonetically decodable books to build fluency and understanding. Develop a pleasure in reading and listening to a range of stories.

MATHS

Addition and subtraction

- Use + and – signs to understand a number sentence.
- Solve one-step addition and subtraction problems using concrete resources.

Geometry

- Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes
- Sort 2D and 3D shapes
- Make patterns with 2D and 3D shapes

PHONICS

We will be recapping all phase 2 and phase 3 sounds.

We will be learning SOME phase 5 sounds:
ay, ou, ie, ea, oy, ir, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew(pew), ew(screw), oe, au, ey, a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, u-e

We will also do a practice phonics screening check.

SCIENCE

Materials (Toys)

- Identify and name a variety of materials.
- Describe the physical properties of everyday materials.
- Use our understanding of materials to design a product fit for purpose.

Exploring beat and pitch

Exploring dynamics, duration and timbre. Relating pitch to graphics symbols. Composing own music using a selection of wind and percussion instruments. Create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.

Toys from the past

- Describe modern toys and explain why we like them.
- Compare toys from the past and the present.
- Sequence toys from the past using a historical timeline.

- Evaluating the final product.

PE

Sending and Receiving

- Send a ball by rolling and throwing underarm.

Dance

- Learn and perform a dance using simple movement patterns.

PSHE

Celebrating difference

- Identify similarities and differences between people in our class.
- Understand what bullying is.
- Learn and explain how to make new friends.

RE

Christianity: Why is the church and Christmas important to Christians?

- Understand why parts of the church are important.
- Re-tell the Christmas story.
- Understand why Christians give and receive presents at Christmas time.
