



## How to access home learning on Google classroom

Log in into your Google account using your email address and password.




Once you have logged in, click on the dotted square that you will find in the top right hand corner of the screen.


This will open up a number of options, click on the classroom icon.



When you are in your virtual classroom, click on your class file. This will open up all the work set.




Once you are in your classroom, along the top you will see four different options. Click on the 'Classwork' tab.



Once you are at the tab, there will be both English and Maths home learning set.







You can click on each of these tabs which will then drop down, explaining the task and have the attachment to be completed. Click on the attachment which will open it on google drive.
